


A Continuing and Graduate Student Guide to IU Scholarships

1. Log in to IU Scholarships by navigating to one.iu.edu.
2. Search for “Scholarships.”
3. Click on the “IU Scholarships” task and log in.



4. Click on “Opportunities” in the header bar.
5. Complete IU’s General Application found in the left hand column.

Thank you for your interest in Indiana University scholarships! The General Application for the Academic Year 2020-2021 is open. You may save your application at any time by clicking **Save and Keep Editing** at the bottom of the form. **CAUTION:** If you input information in all required fields – even if that information is incomplete – clicking the Save and Keep Editing button will submit your application. You will receive a submitted application email notification and it will appear to scholarship committees that your application is finished. Please note, your application can be saved, edited and submitted at any time before the application deadline. Once complete, you can submit your application by clicking **Finish and Submit**.

Note: Required fields are marked with an asterisk. (*)

For scholarship eligibility purposes, do not use an email account that you share with someone else, even if it is a parent or sibling. Using a **shared email may delay or postpone the processing of your scholarship application(s)**. If you do not already have an IU email address, you should create one; see [Create first computing accounts for admitted students, faculty, staff, affiliates, and those returning to IU](#).

Monitor your IU Email account for notifications of future scholarship opportunities. For more information about scholarships, contact the [Office of Scholarships](#) on your campus.

This application is also open for IUPUI students applying to scholarships for the 2020 spring semester.

Save and Keep Editing Finish and Submit

Please note that this is a very lengthy application that has the capacity to be extremely detailed but **you need only answer seven required questions:**

1. Did you or will you complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the upcoming academic year?
2. What campus or campuses are you considering attending?
3. When do you expect to graduate from an IU Campus?
4. What is your intended enrollment status for the upcoming academic year? (full-time, at least half-time, less than half-time)
5. Do you plan to work during the school year?
6. Required Scholarship Essay. If you do not feel you would like to disclose any of the information requested in the essay prompts, you do not need to. However, including information about financial hardships and/or future career goals may help the selections committees determine your eligibility for certain awards. If you don't wish to include an essay, simply type anything into this field (i.e. "N/A").
7. Are you ready to submit your general application? Select "Yes"

6. Then type your name into the Signature Statement at the bottom the page.

* Signature Statement:

Please DO NOT enter your name until you are ready to submit your General Application.

By submitting this scholarship application, I confirm that any essays or other requested materials for this application are my own original work. I hereby certify that all information I submit to Indiana University is true and correct. I understand that any misrepresentation of the facts may be cause for scholarship denial or cancellation.




7. Click the red Finish and Submit button.

8. Once you've completed the General Application you will see the option to complete a Conditional Application in your Application Progress column.



9. Follow the instructions on the conditional application carefully and answer all applicable questions. The answers to these questions will be applied to nearly all of the department's opportunities.

10. Other recommended opportunities may also be available to you from other departments. click on the "Opportunities" dropdown in the grey header bar and then select "Recommended." You will see a list of scholarships or fellowships for which you are eligible to apply.



11. Click the red “Apply” button to begin the process of applying for each of these opportunities individually. Each opportunity will likely have a unique set of questions or requirements to complete the application for that specific scholarship or fellowship.
